

Pedagogical Values at SEA – Business Academy

The pedagogical values form the framework for our teaching culture and for how we work with learning, education, and competence development at SEA. The values support our ambition to educate skilled, reflective, and responsible graduates who can create value in business and society.

1. Student-centred learning with feedback

Students are active co-creators of their own learning. The lecturer acts as an academic leader, facilitator, and sparring partner, providing structure, direction, and progression in teaching. Clear learning objectives, academic expectations, and continuous feedback support reflection, academic development, and progression. Teaching is designed to challenge all students and support their development from their current level.

2. Practice-oriented teaching aligned with the real world

Teaching is closely linked to industry and society through authentic cases, projects, and collaboration with external partners. Theory and practice are integrated so that students develop competencies that are relevant and applicable in professional contexts.

3. Collaboration

Learning develops through interaction with others. Students work in teams and interdisciplinary contexts, where they develop collaboration skills, communication, and professional responsibility. Lecturers and students actively contribute to a learning environment characterised by respect, dialogue, and trust.

4. Curiosity and critical thinking

Teaching promotes curiosity and the ability to analyse, reflect, and act in complex situations. Students are trained in critical thinking, creative problem-solving, and reflection on their own practice.

5. Responsible graduates

Digital literacy, sustainability, ethics, and cultural awareness are integrated perspectives in teaching. We educate graduates who can navigate a complex world and contribute responsibly and create value in both businesses and society.
